
Mounting challenges for First Quantum in Panama

The week saw significant moves in the share price of First Quantum Minerals, the operator of the Cobre Panama copper mine, as the National Assembly of Panama held sessions concerning bills relating both to the revised contract for the operation of the copper mine, enacted into law in October, and a moratorium on the granting of new mining concessions. In addition to ongoing environmental concerns, certain lawmakers and protestors believe that the contract is overly generous and there may have been corruption. In a statement, First Quantum emphasised that it is "committed to the principles of integrity and transparency in its dealings with governments around the world." The Cobre mine, which accounts for 1% of global copper production, remains operational. According to Reuters, local experts see the matter being resolved in the country's top court because any legislative move to void the contract would likely lead to international arbitration.

After Hancock Prospecting, another Australian miner, Minerals Resources, has been building a position in Azure Minerals. In an ASX annoucement on 3 November, it <u>indicated</u> that it has built up a 12.3% holding, spending more than A\$210 million to acquire shares since mid October. The bulk of the shares are held through Wodgina Lithium Pty Ltd. Mineral Resouces has a number of lithium interests in Australia including the Wodgina lithium operation, a JV with Albemarle, at which Mineral Resources is responsible for all mining operations and the 750,000 tonnes per annum spodumene plant. Mineral Resources has yet to comment on its interest in Azure Minerals, but the intent, given its record of working with Hancock Prospecting in Western Australia, would seem to be clear.

SSE Renewables <u>announced</u> that it has taken a Final Investment Decision (FID) to proceed with the construction of a 320MW / 640MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) projects in Monk Fryston, Yorkshire. The batteries at the project, which is located next to a National Grid substation, will be able to run for up to two hours at a time. A 150MW BESS site in the former SSE coal-power station at Fiddler's Ferry has also been consented with construction potentially beginning next year subject to reaching a FID.


